



Late Breaking Abstract Submission

Abstract submission open: 12 September 2022

Submission closes: 19 September 2022

A late-breaking abstract should contain new data that was not yet known or fully available by the general abstract submission deadline (14 May 2022). The data in the abstract must not be published prior to the meeting.

Please note that late-breaking abstract deadline is not an extension of the abstract submission deadline.

The data must be novel, ground-breaking, of high significance, evidence-based and with scientific merit.

The data must be original and not previously published or presented at any other scientific meeting.

A limited number of late-breaking abstracts will be accepted.

Submissions will be accepted for oral presentation only.

REGULATIONS

With the submission of a late-breaking abstract for EUSEM 2022, the submitting (presenting) author:

- Accepts responsibility for the accuracy of the abstract and confirms that all authors are aware of the content before submission
- Accepts to be the contact person for all correspondence related to the abstract and to inform the co-authors about its status
- Accepts to declare any financial interest in products or processes described in the abstract. This includes stock ownership, membership on any advisory boards, commercially-sponsored research or any other substantial relationships
- Selected Abstracts are embargoed until the day of presentation and will be published in the searchable programme on that day.
- Abstracts must be submitted and presented at the conference in English. Abstract Committee reserves the right to reject an abstract written in poor English.
